




Unique Safety Fastener Gets Upgrade for Anniversary of Northridge Quake

To apply QuakeWax, scoop out a little bit using the pick provided in the container and roll it into balls or strips. Then apply it to the base of the object to be fastened and press the object down onto the surface of the shelf on which it is to be displayed. To remove the object, just twist and lift it from the base.
